Dig deep for a decent tripod and it will give you many years of service, making it a sensible long-term investment. Moving in close is also a good technique to use in portrait photography. Set your camera to use the flash by either popping up the flash or enabling the flash feature in the menu.

If you're out on a planned shoot try taking a few photos while you're on a break. Hand-held or tripod mounted? My theory is that while they are useful to know and employ that they are also useful to know so you can purposely break them – as this can lead to eye catching results. Want to sell your photos?

If your camera has a lens that sits out from the body, use your left hand to support it. Make sure no poles grow from the head of your favorite niece and that no cars seem to dangle from her ears. Elaine Lipson.
